## Grad Night

Due to the Covid-19 and the cancelation of the 2020 Grad Night, MSHS PTSA signed a Refund agreement with Grad Nights. The agreement will provide the following: **1) 50% immediate cash refund: \$10,886.50 2) 5% credit for the Classes of 2021-2025: \$1,088.65 each year, totaling \$5,443.25, if MSHS PTSA contracts with Grad Nights.**

- The \$10,886.50 cash refund will be taken into income in this FY and a new budget income line item will be created for the refund.
- The last installment to Grad Nights 2020 contract was not paid out due to Covid-19 and the cancelation of the event. This amount, approx. \$9K is currently in our cash balance and this will be used with the Grad Nights cash refund to make up the refunds to families.
- Additionally, it was discussed to include a \$5443 donation from the PTSA to be included in the refund amount.
- With the \$10,886.50 cash refund, approx. \$9K unpaid portion and the \$5,443 donation we can provide the fullest refund to participants up front, which would be \$150.
